PAD System™ Plot Manager product allows you to stack files to be plotted through the network. These files can be Pattern files and/or Marker files. Plot Manager product allows you to generate plot order, determine quantity and establish pauses. Most importantly, you can continue working on your applications without having to remain on standby while launched files are plotted.



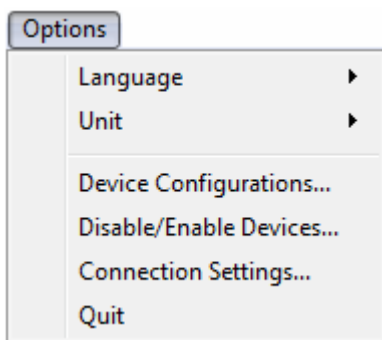

Options Menu

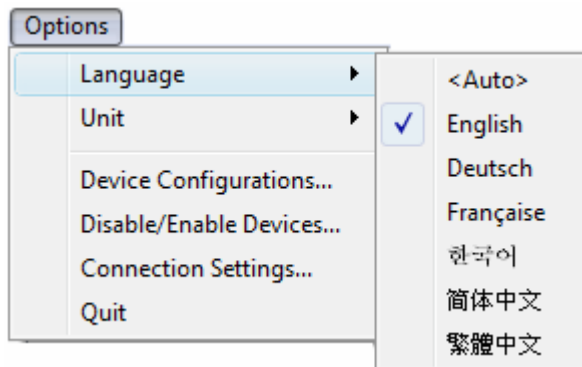
The *Options* menu allows you to customize your application.





Options Menu: Language

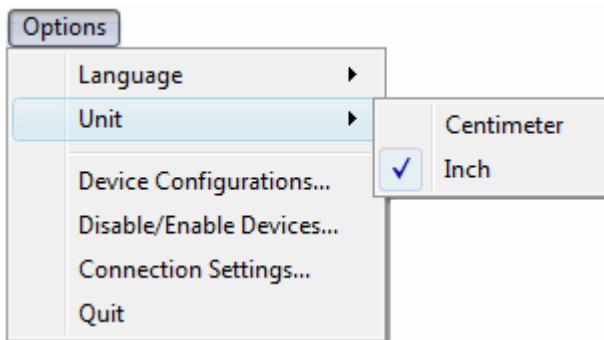
The *Language* item allows you to define the language showing on the product. To choose *Auto from the list*, the language will be showing according the language of the operating system.





Options Menu: Unit

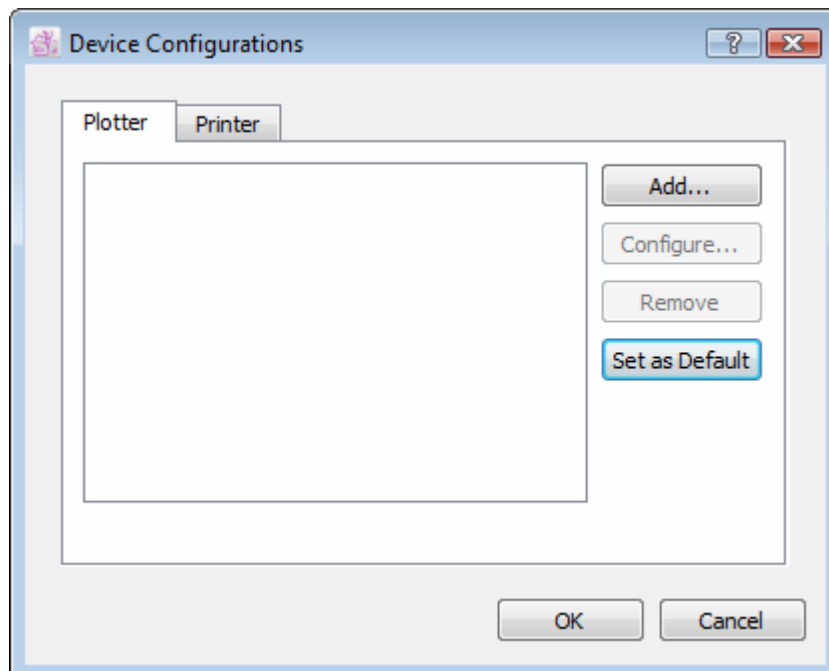
The *Unit* in the *Options* menu allows user to select the desired measurement unit (Centimeter or Inch).



Options Menu: Device Configurations....

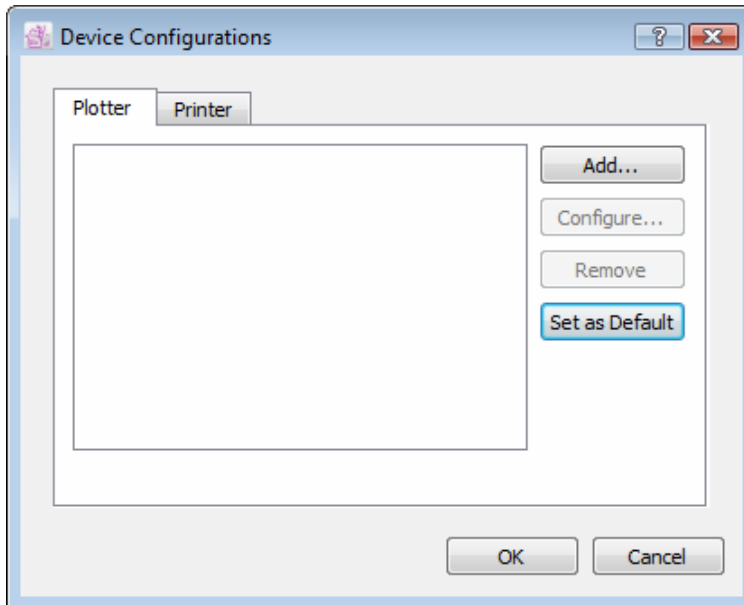
The *Device Configurations* item, in the *Options* menu, enables you to select, from a list of drivers, the driver that corresponds to your plotter. This enables your plotter to connect to PAD System™ software.

From the Device Configurations dialog box, user can add / set the built-in plotter driver of Pad System under "Plotter" as default; or, choose to add / set your own Windows printer driver, under the "Printer" part.

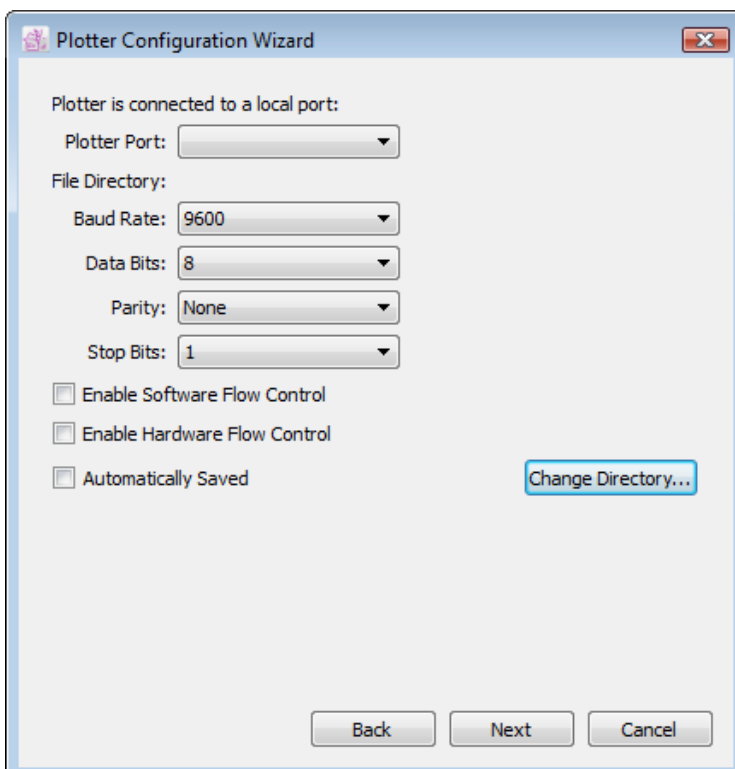


To configure plotter driver:

- 1 Select *Option* menu; choose *Device Configurations...*, a dialog box appears:



- 2 Click *Add...* to choose a plotter that is connected to the local port from the list. "Plotter Configuration Wizard" dialog box shown as below:





To configure the port setting COM Port (Windows) / Serial Port (Macintosh) if necessary.

Plotter Port: Pull-down menu to select the type of port connected to the plotter.

Baud Rate: Pull-down menu with options - 2400, 4800, 9600, 19200 or 38400 bauds.

Data Bits: Pull-down menu with options - 7 / 8 data bits.

Parity: Pull-down menu with options - EVEN, ODD or NONE.

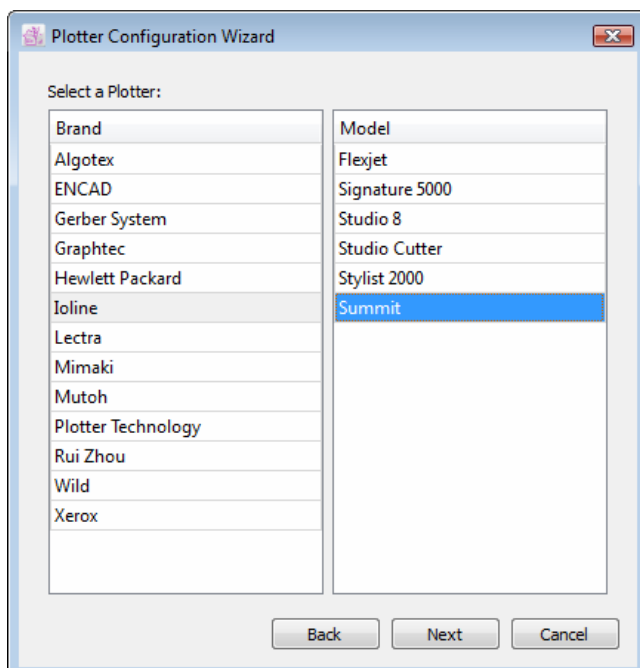
Stop Bits: Pull-down menu with options - 1, 1.5 or 2 data bits.

Enable Software Flow Control: Check / Uncheck this option

Enable Hardware Flow Control: Check / Uncheck the option

Click Next to continue the configuration process.

3 Choose the *Plotter* and click *Next* button to continue.

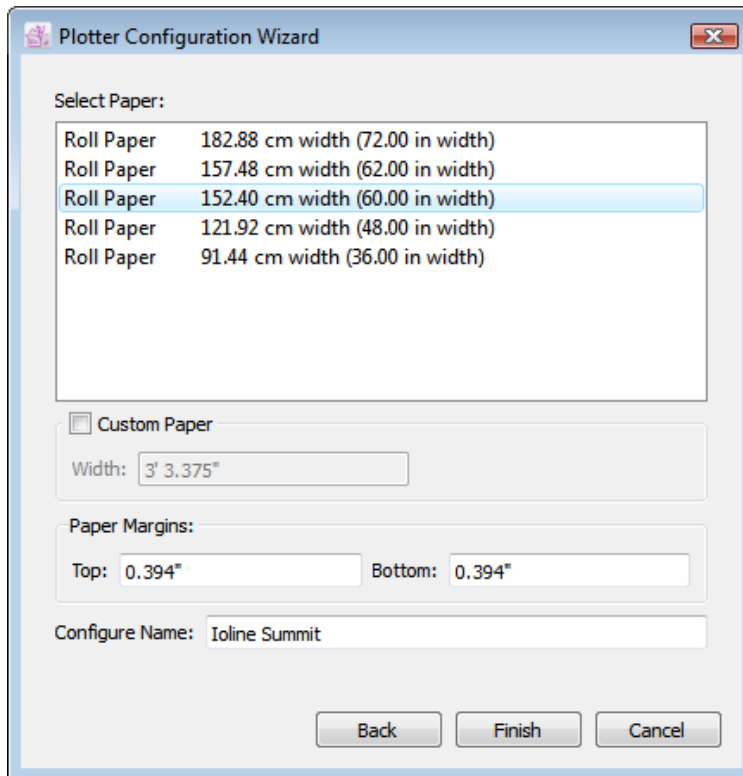

Select Paper: Choose the default *Paper Width* from the list.

Example: Roll Paper 157.48 cm width (62.00 in width)

If the Actual Paper Width is 62.00, user has to add the print margins at the *Paper Margins text boxes* (since print size and actual paper size is different).

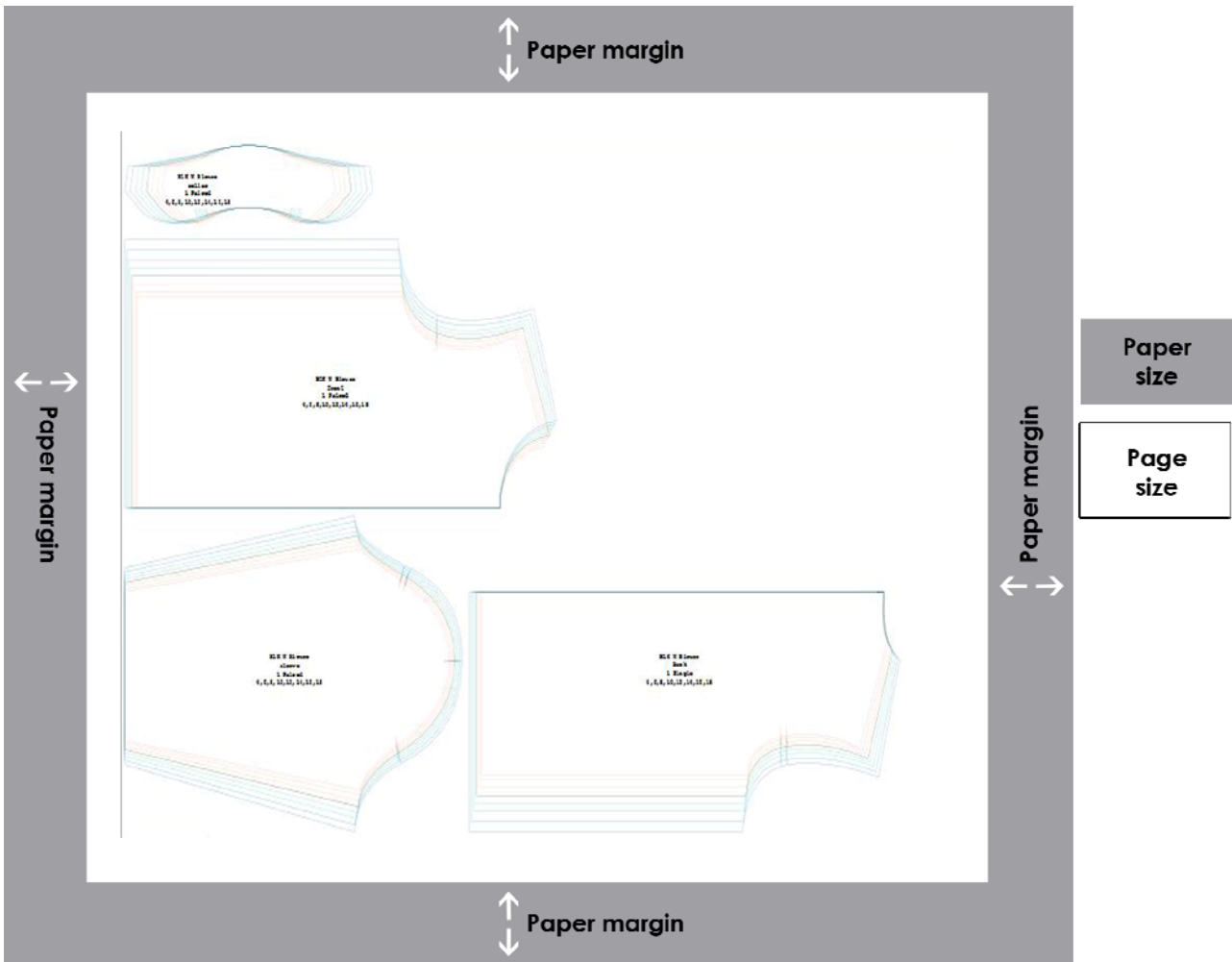
Custom Paper: Check to customize the paper width.

Paper Margins: Set the paper margins - Top and Bottom.

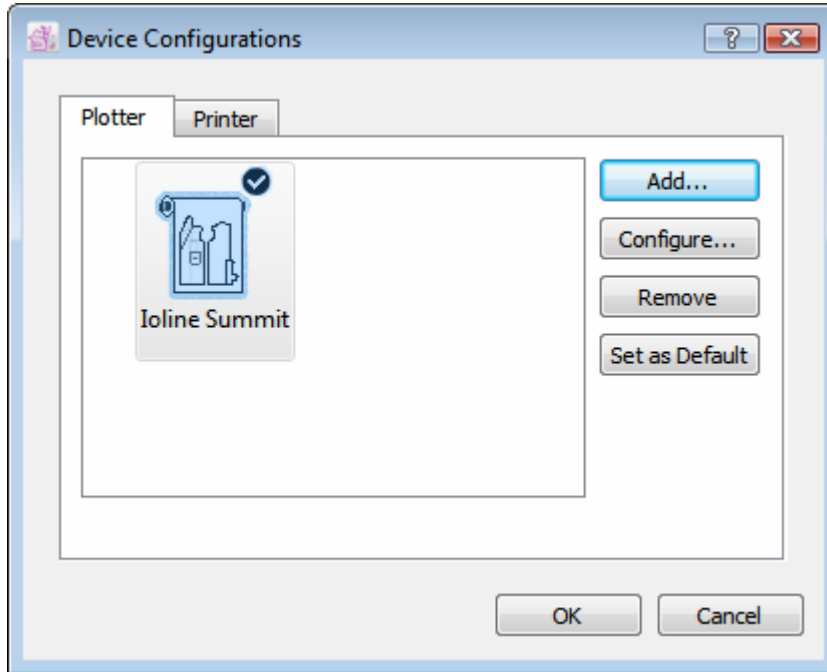
Configure Name: Show the selected plotter name from previous settings.

Click *Finish* to execute.

Configure...: Change the setting of the selected driver. Click *Configure...* or double click the mouse button on selected driver to change the setting or the driver of existing Plotter.

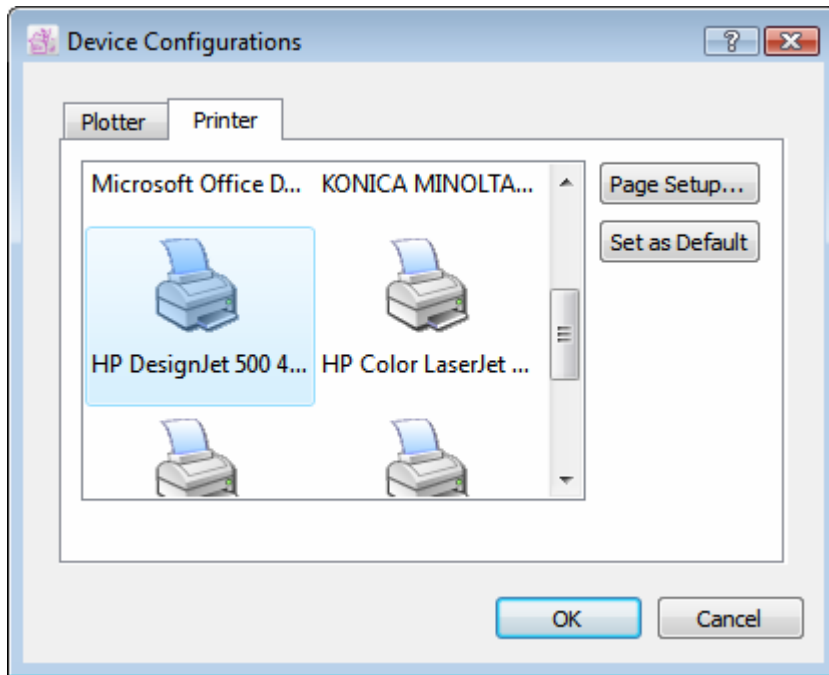
Remove: Click *Remove* to remove selected driver.

Set as Default: Choose the selected Plotter then click for setting as default.



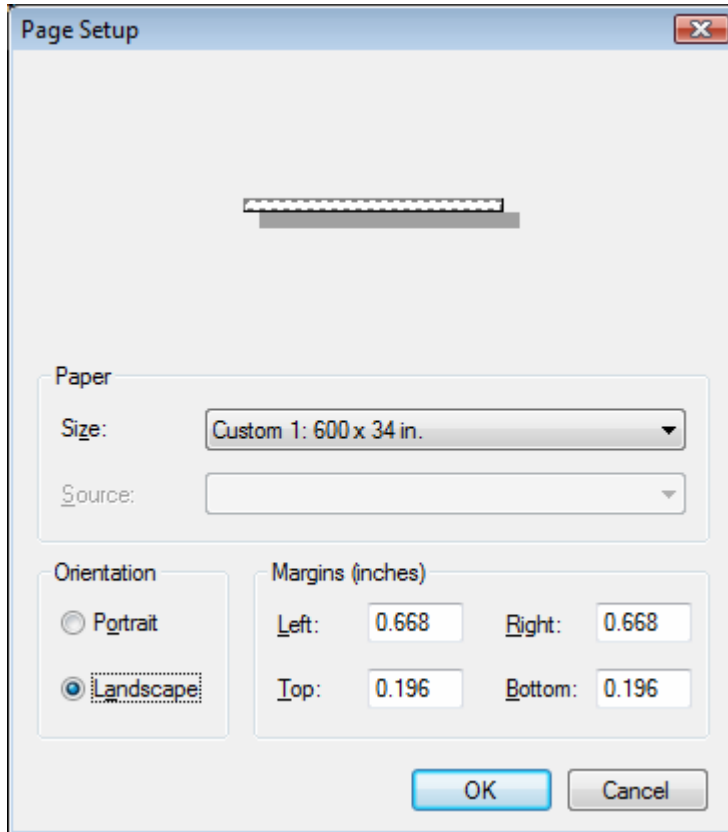
To configure printer driver:

You should install the driver of your selected printer. The Printer driver will be updated in the "Printer" options once the drive has been successfully installed.





Page Setup...: Allows to choose the paper size, set margins and/ or orientation.



Click *OK* to apply the setting.

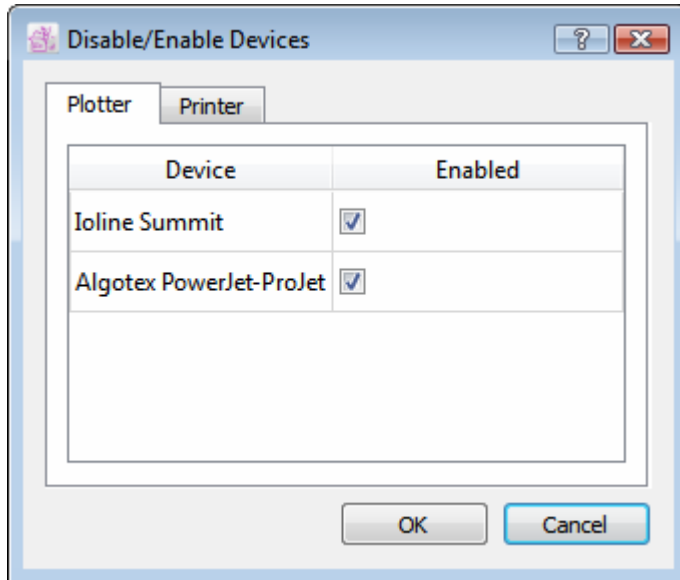
Set as Default: Choose the selected Printer, click *Set as Default* button to save as a default printer.

The printer driver will show on the Device Configurations dialog box.



Options Menu: Disable/Enable Device...

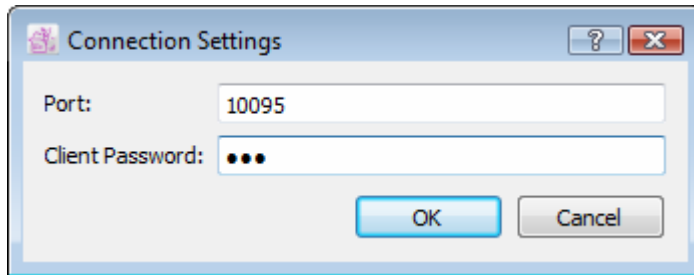
This option allows disabling the plotter and user is not able to send plot job to this plotter.

Click *OK* to execute.

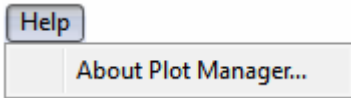


Options Menu: Quit

By clicking the *About[name of your application]...* item the *Help* menu, you can view:

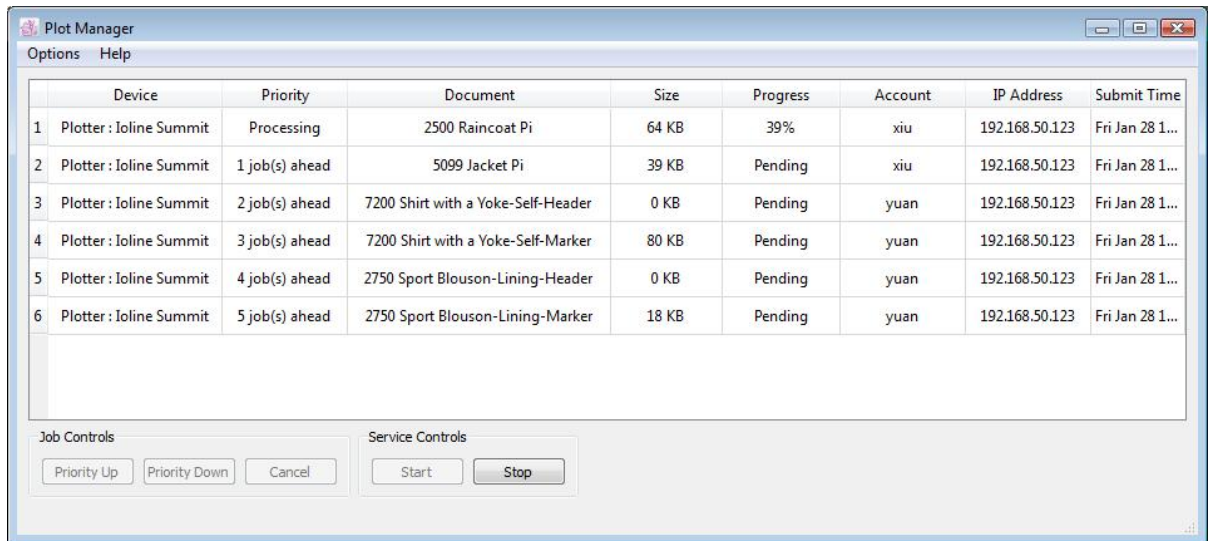
- The name and version of the application installed.



Chapter 2

Plot Manager Windows

The PAD System Plot Manager window is divided into three sections:

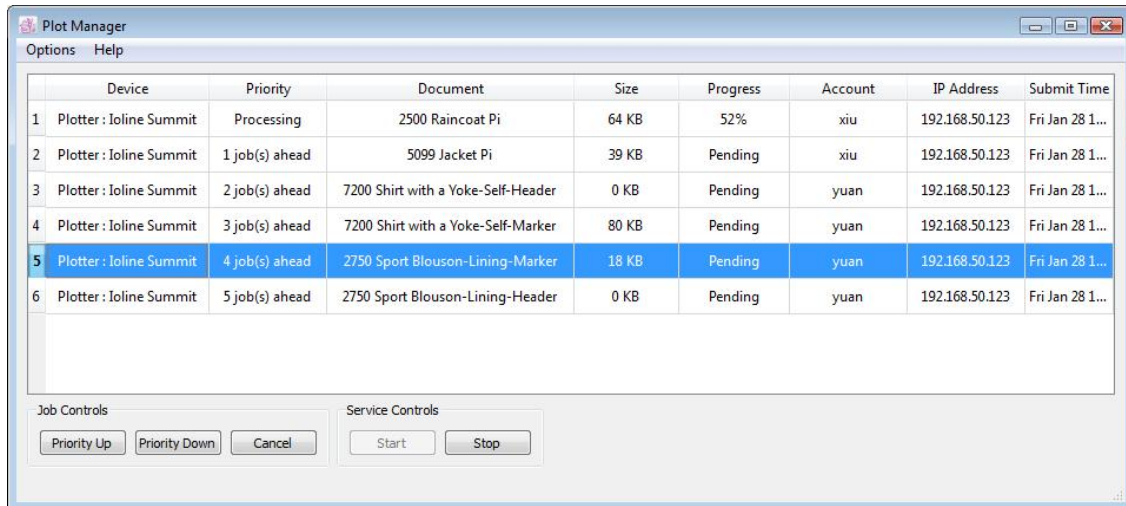


- The top section displays information about the file being plotted.
- The middle section displays all the files to be plotted.
- The bottom section displays command buttons that enable you to organize the listed files to be plotted.

Job Controls

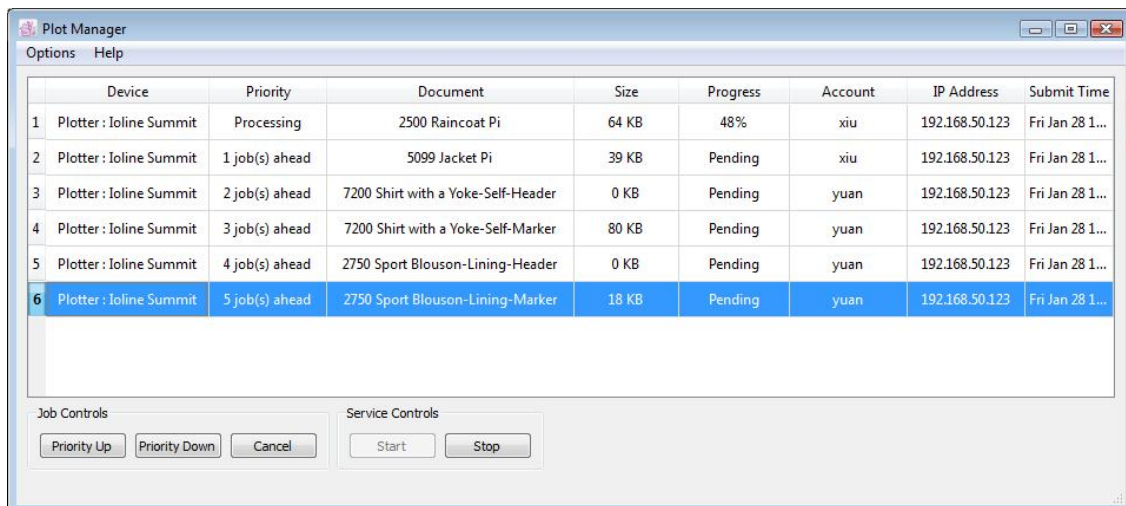
Priority Up: Move up the plotted file to be a high priority in the job list.

Priority Down: Move down the plotted file to low priority from the job list.



Select the plot job you wish to move, then press *Priority Down* button.

The selected plot job moves to your desired location.



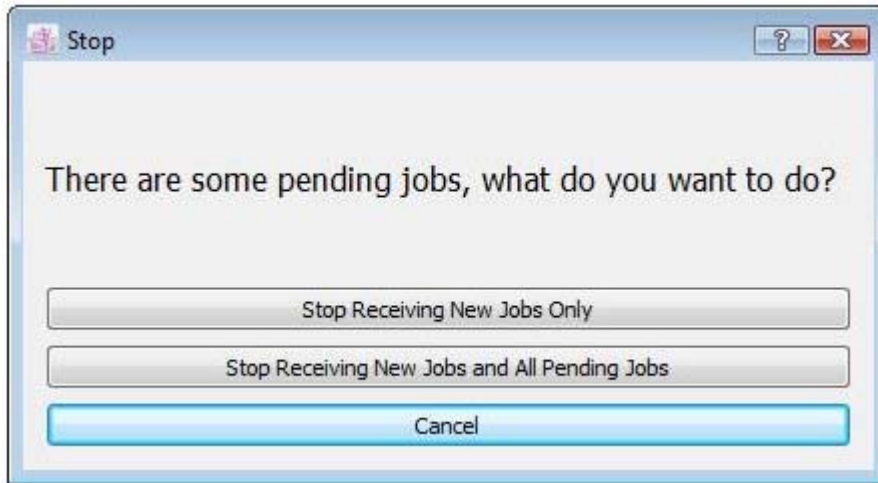
Cancel: Delete the plot job from the list.



Service Controls

Start: Press *Start* button to connect the client and receive the plotted files. And start to plot from the default plotter.

Stop: Press *Stop* button to disable the connection for plotting.
